National Dutch Championships – Dutch Shepherds


On the 6th of November in Holland the National Dutch Championship Dutch Shepherd IGP was held and that was quite a historical moment.

Years ago, the Dutch Championship IPO / IGP was the start of a yearly moment when the Dutch Shepherd family came together. Even people who were not participants, came to Holland – Hoogkerk, to enjoy the competition, the dogs, the friendship and to share the same breed preference for the Dutch Shepherd. Because most everyone had a brother/sister/mother/uncle etc of the dogs which participated, it really felt like a 'Dutch Family'.

Because participants were not only from Holland, but from all over the world, and came to compete at these Championships, the idea was born to set up a real-World Championship. And so, the World Dutch Shepherd Federation was born.

The rest is history, and we are proud the WDSF has grown into a worldwide organization. Since the start of the WDSF and her World Championships in 2014, participation in the Dutch Championship decreased. People had to choose between the championships to prepare their dogs. That was understandable, but very unfortunate. No championship took place between 2017 and 2020. This was partly due to a reduced field of participants, but of course also due to Covid.





The public was again well represented. Not only from the Netherlands, but also from other European countries and even from the USA. The old feeling came back a bit. We are proud of it and can look back on a very successful Dutch Championship.
